How to book appointments

- We offer same day face-to-face and telephone appointments for GPs, advanced practitioners and the nurse-led acute Illness clinic: appointments are released on the day from 8 am for morning appointments and 12 noon for the afternoon clinics.
- Appointments with nurses, healthcare assistants and the pharmacist can be booked up to 6 weeks in advance.
- You can book your appointment via telephone, online or at reception. Our telephone lines can be very busy at times but we will answer your call as quickly as possible.

Extended hours service - GP Care Wakefield GP Care Wakefield is an extended hours service based at **Trinity Medical Centre and Pontefract General Infirmary.** It is owned by all Wakefield GP Practices to cover the entire population of the Wakefield District.

It operates from 6pm-10pm Monday to Friday, and 9am-3pm Saturdays, Sundays and Bank Holidays. For booking just phone the normal surgery telephone and the call will be automatically diverted to a triage centre.

The service is not available for routine matters or repeat prescriptions or conditions that will require an onward referral

GP Care Wakefield also offers routine nurse and HCA appointments.

These appointments are booked through the surgery and are

available after 6pm Monday to Friday and 9am-3pm on a weekend.

Patients can be seen for annual reviews of heart disease, diabetes, COPD, asthma & stroke but only if you are well controlled and your condition is stable.



Other routine nurse care includes: blood tests, routine ECGs (not chest pain), spirometry, contraceptive pill reviews, repeat depo injections, B12 injections, removal of sutures/clips.

Please note that you need to ensure you have consented to information sharing to book this appointment.



GP home visits

House visits are for patients who are too ill or infirm to travel to the surgery. It is always better to attend the surgery where possible so that a more thorough examination can be undertaken if required and tests done where appropriate.

Please telephone the surgery before 10 am to request a visit.

Appointment reminder text service

We can send an appointment reminder by text to your mobile phone one day before your appointment. Please ensure that we have the correct number on record and inform us if you change your number.

This service has been very successful in reducing the number of missed appointments and so increasing appointment availability for patients.

Test results

Please call our telephone numbers (option 4) between 10 am and 6pm to enquire about your test results.

Due to data protection regulations we are only able to release test results to the person to whom they relate unless we have written permission from the patient allowing us to provide this information.

It is your responsibility to check your results and to make an appointment to discuss them with your doctor if you are advised to do so.





Prescriptions

How to request a repeat prescription:

- subscribe to our online services and submit your request online
- or bring a tear-off slip to the surgery and mark required items

If you need medication that is **not listed on the repeat**, please speak to a member of staff - for some medication you might need a telephone consultation with a clinician.

It can take up to 2 working days for us to process prescriptions, and in some cases it may take longer.

How you can help us process your request faster:

- request the medication online
- nominate a pharmacy so that we can send prescriptions directly (electronically) to the pharmacy of your choice

Save your time - subscribe to our online services!

We can offer your medication review as a telephone consultation or face-to-face appointment with our pharmacist - you can book your appointment in advance.

If you run out of your regular medication when the surgery is closed or you are away (within the UK territory), please ring 111 to request your medication to be send to a nearby pharmacy.








How to find us and our boundaries
